**NEW PARADE ROUTE!** The parade will begin at 4<sup>th</sup> & Elm Street, turn left on Third Street and travel straight down Third Street. The judges' stage will be located at Third & Washington Streets. An estimated 30,000 spectators attend every year. If you have any questions, kindly contact Juan J. Each town in Puerto Rico celebrates las fiestas patronales, which are the Patron Saint Festivals, and many towns have additional festivals, which honor cultural icons like Bomba y Plena, Danza, Salsa, hamacas and popular crops such as plantains and coffee. Puerto Rico puts a premium on celebration!

In honor of Saint John the Baptist, the patron saint of the Puerto Rico, the San Juan Bautista Parade has become the largest parade and festival in the Camden/South Jersey region. Everyone is welcome to participate!

## RULES OF PARTICIPATION

1. All participants must submit a completed Parade Application Form by the date established by the San Juan Bautista Parade Committee. **No walk on/last minute sign ups will be permitted.**
2. All participants must pay a \$25 registration fee by the date established by the Committee. Please make checks payable to the Parada San Juan Bautista, Inc.
3. All participants must check-in at the registration table, located at 4<sup>th</sup> & Elm Streets, on the day of the Parade. Participants will be given a number which must be displayed at all times during the parade. The numbers will be collected at the Judges Reviewing Stage.
4. Line-up begins at 9:00 a.m. on Parade Day at the Rafael Cordero Molina School, Seventh & Elm Streets in Camden, New Jersey. Kick-off shall be at 12:00 p.m. **SHARP!**
5. All vehicles in the parade must be decorated and in good working order and must comply with the Motor Vehicle Laws of the State of New Jersey. The operator's driver's license, registration card and insurance policy must be presented. **There shall be no more than (five) 5 vehicles per one entry (per participant).**
6. Participants must supply their own music and/or sound equipment (CD players, CD's, etc.). The Committee assumes no responsibility for the participant's music and/or sound equipment.
7. Participants are limited to three (3) minutes for their performance at the Judges Reviewing Stage. All music must be cued and ready to play at the stage. Music **MUST** be in "**GOOD TASTE**" with **ABSOLUTELY** no foul language.
8. Within the discretion of the Committee, participants' attire **MUST** be in "**GOOD TASTE**".
9. Participants may not engage in political campaigning nor distribute political propaganda during the parade.
10. Participants may not consume and/or distribute alcohol and/or illegal drugs during the parade.
11. Participants may not engage in any activity that may represent a safety hazard to the participants or spectators, throw flowers, fruits, flyers, etc. Items may be handed out, not thrown.
12. Puerto Rican flags with any other emblem and/or design will **NOT** be permitted in the parade. Any altered Puerto Rican flags will be immediately removed from the parade.
13. Violation of these rules will constitute grounds for removal from the parade.
14. Groups with active San Juan Bautista Parade Committee members participating in the parade are exempt from receiving awards.
15. Awards Presentations will be at the Post-Parade Concert at approximately 6:30 p.m. Only the contact person listed on the Participation Form will be eligible to receive the award. The Parade Committee shall be the final arbitrator of all awards.

## **PARADE CATEGORIES**

### **MARCHING UNIT:**

Any groups of individuals marching in formation; including color guards, drill teams, baton units, marching bands, military and/or uniformed units, and fraternal orders/lodges.

### **DANCE GROUP:**

Any group of dancers performing a particular dance, regardless of the dances' origins.

### **FLOATS:**

Traditional decorated floats including decorated flat bed trucks adorned as a float.

### **DECORATED AUTO:**

Any individual decorated automobiles including vans, convertibles and antique cars.

**NO TRACTOR TRAILERS WITHOUT A FLOAT, MOTORCYCLES, QUADS, MINI-BIKES, DIRT BIKES; GO CARTS, OFF ROAD VEHICLES, ETC., ARE PERMITTED IN THE PARADE, UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.**

### **ATHLETIC GROUP:**

Groups of individuals walking together representing sport teams such as little leagues, baseball/softball teams, bowling leagues, etc.

### **INDIVIDUAL PERFORMANCE:**

The participation and performance by a (1) person in the parade.

### **EXEMPT FROM RECEIVING AWARDS**

1. Participants paid by the Parada San Juan Bautista, Inc. to be in the parade.
2. Political entities, including political candidates, elected officials and political action committees.
3. Groups with active membership in the Parada San Juan Bautista, Inc. participating in the parade are exempt from receiving awards.
